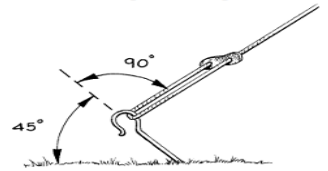
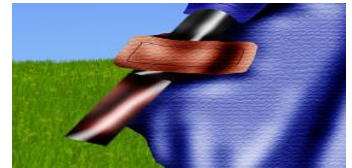
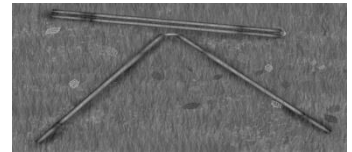




## Pitch a Dome Tent Skills Card

1. Find a suitable piece of ground; flat with no sharp objects sticking out.
2. Empty the tents and its contents from the bag and lay them out so that you can see what the tent consists of.
3. Assemble the poles. These are often held together with elastic shock cord. Make sure the doors are closed then attach the poles by sliding them through the sleeves. These sleeves are often colour coded at the end of the seam to the colour of the pole.
4. Peg out the groundsheet (inner). Metal pegs can often be pushed into the ground by hand. Set the peg at 45 degrees to the ground and 90 degrees to the guy lines.
5. Peg out the remaining loops and guy lines around the tent. Remember the loops should be stretched in line with the seam on the tent. The tent should now be upright and free of creases.
6. Place the flysheet over the poles of the tent to form the outer 'shell'. Make sure it does not touch the inner tent.



**Note:** In some tents the poles are attached to the flysheet and the inner is then attached and hung inside the flysheet.
