



My World – Global Development Goals

Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) are the international common target in the field of global development. The basic idea of the MDGs was designed in September 2000, when world leaders came together for the UN Millennium Declaration to reduce extreme poverty and setting out a series of time-bound targets with a deadline of 2015. 8 MDGs includes such as eradicate extreme poverty and hunger, achieve universal primary education.



It is time for us to think about the next series of development target. Consider some post-MDGs targets by participating the “My World” survey, a global vote on the post MDGs agenda.

1. Find out about the MDGs, their progress, and how far we are to achieve the goals.
2. Print out the list of 16 points, taken from the “My World” survey, on the next page for each scout. Ask the participants to choose 6 points that matter most from the two perspectives: “What are most important for you and your family?” and “What are most important for our planet?”. Scouts can choose the same points both perspectives.
3. Ask Scouts to explain the reasons for choosing some of the 6 points. Then, discuss different reasons for the points chosen.
4. Compile a patrol list where you collectively chose six main points.
5. Later, have each scout Vote on the official “My World Survey for Scouts” vote.myworld2015.org/scouts
