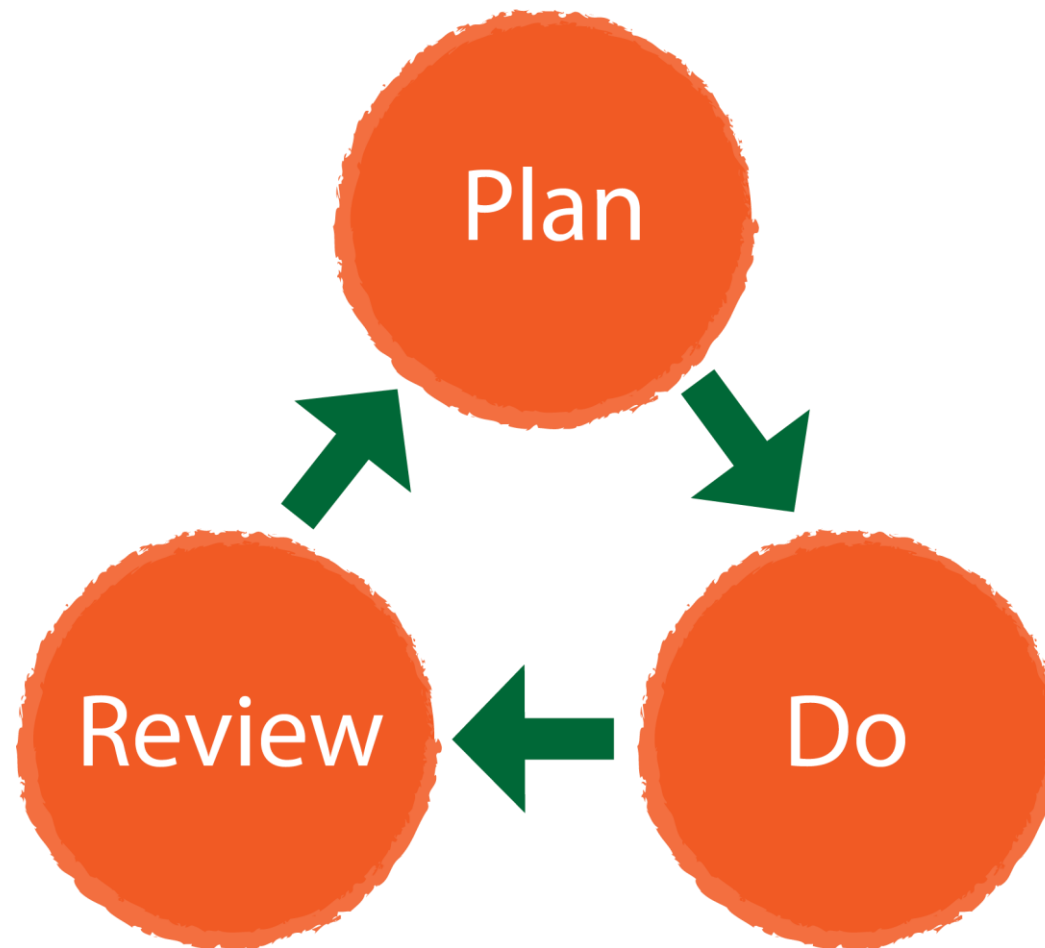


Programme Cycles: Plan, Do, Review

- Helping plan the next activity





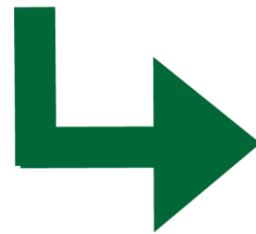

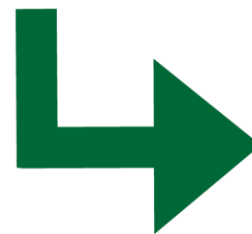

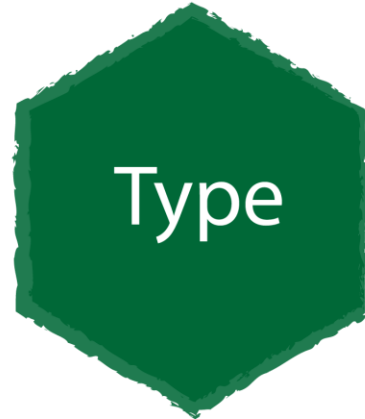
Activities

- The Activity Leader coordinates

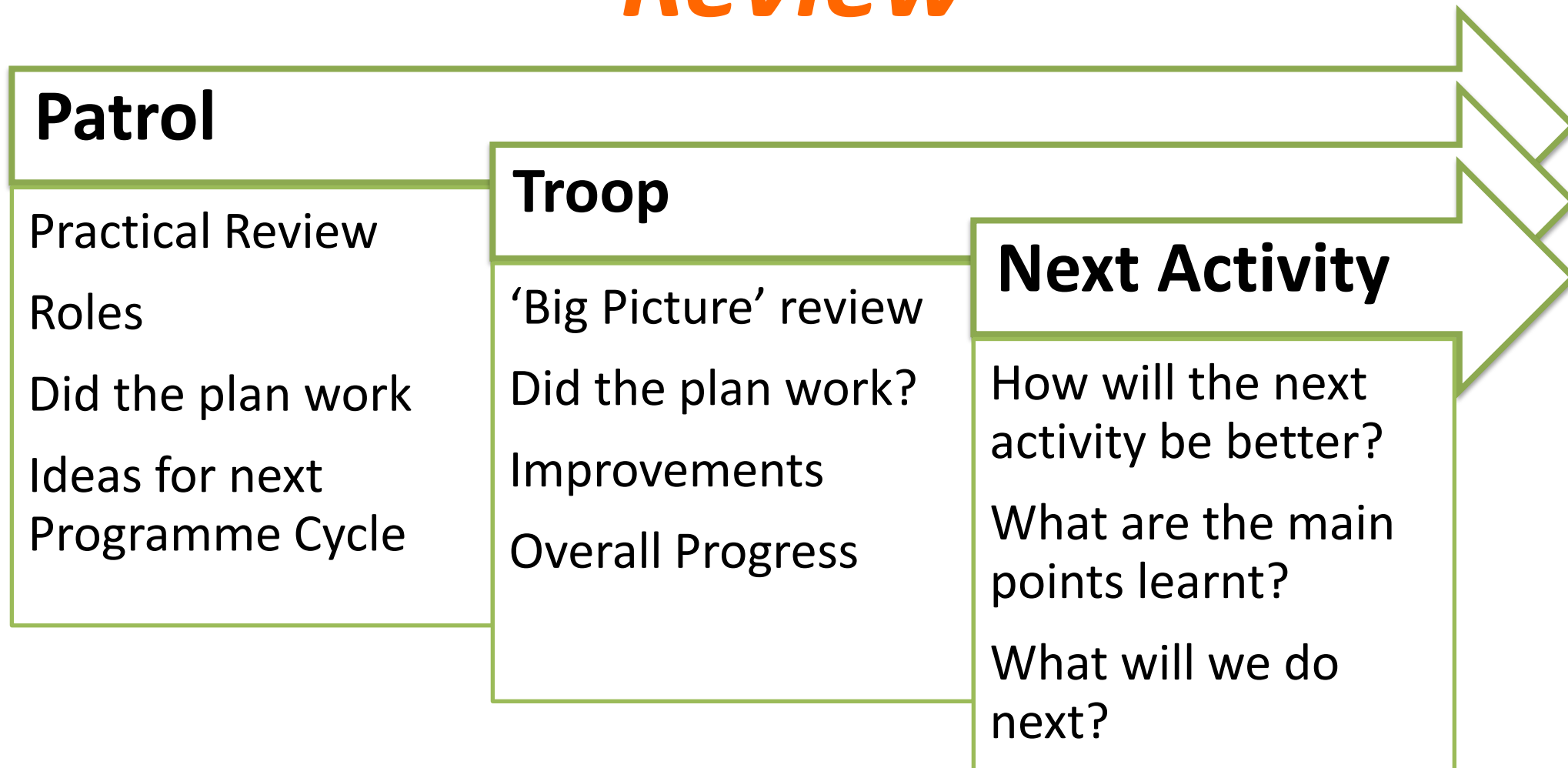
Type

The type of activity depends on the Ad. Skills, Special Interests and the CSA.





Review



Patrols: Activities should be reviewed; many of these will be quick and brief evaluations. It is about looking at the what went well, what could be improved and what has been learnt.

Troop: Using the Patrol Reviews, the PLs, APLs, and Scouters can take a 'big picture' look in evaluating the programme. These reviews help PLs and APLs understand how the programme works and give ideas for the next programme cycle.



Badgework Assessment

Patrol

- Progress towards **Crean Awards & SPICES**
- PLs/APLs assess and guide other Scouts
- Ensure activities are helping achieve Crean Awards for all scouts
- Complete parts of Ad. Skills, SIBs, CSA

Patrol Leaders' Council

- Progress towards **Crean Awards & SPICES** for PLs & APLs
- PLs/APLs and Scouters assess and guide
- Ensures everyone is getting opportunities to achieve their Crean Awards

Badgework assessment can be run separately to the practical review. During Patrol meetings, the PL and APL help the other scouts assess their progress in their badgework (Crean Awards, Ad. Skills, etc) and decide on what they need to do next.

At some PLC meetings, PLs and APLs to assess and work on their own badgework. They can review and plan their Crean Awards and other badges with the input of both other Scouts and Scouters.
