



Getting Active for National Council 2016

Group

- Your Group will nominate four delegates to National Council. At least ONE of these must be a registered Youth Member. Make sure your Group has at least one Youth Member attending, and more if you can, and that these names are submitted to National Office by Friday 4th March.
- Attend your Group Council meeting and contribute to discussions on National Council, including the motions and elections. Remember, that your Group Council includes a representative from each of the Scout Section, the Venture Scout Section, and the Rover Scout Section; also the Rover Scouts elect three members.
- Some Group Councils make decisions on motions and elections and the delegates vote this way at National Council, while others have their delegates listen to the discussions and decide on the day. Either way, it is important that you are involved in these discussions and decisions.

County

- Each Scout County Forum (Scouts, venture Scouts, and Rover Scouts) can send two named representatives. A meeting of County Reps can discuss National Council to help Reps going to National Council in voting on behalf of the Forum.
- Scout County Management Committees may also meet to discuss National Council. Remember that this Committee includes two Reps from each Scout County Forum (Scouts, Venture Scouts, and Rover Scouts) who should attend and contribute.

Province

- Attend and participate in the Meet the Candidates sessions, which are running in each Province. There you can hear directly from the candidates and ask them questions.

National
